

AAG Council Meeting - Key Decisions

(April 14 – 16, 2024)

1. Council adopted a balanced budget for Fiscal Year 2025.
2. Council is considering changing the AAG's fiscal year to a calendar year cadence.
3. Council approved adding Special Issues to the GeoHumanities journal, starting in 2027.
4. Council approved the scope and charge for the Climate Action Committee, which will become a new Standing Committee of the AAG to advise the AAG on reducing the carbon footprint of AAG meetings.
5. Council appointed National Councilor Antoinette WinklerPrins as the next AAG Treasurer, and Southeastern Councilor Heidi Lannon as Chair of the Regional Division Councilors.
6. AAG will soon roll out a new form, allowing members to indicate their interest in volunteering with the AAG on committees, task forces, or to stand for election.
